This symposium is organized by Research Center for Water Environment Technology (RECWET) in the University of Tokyo (UT) and Southeast Asian Center for Water Environment Technology (SACWET) in AIT in cooperation with Ministry of the Environment (MOE) and Chuo University in Japan.

The purpose of this Symposium is to provide a forum for networking various participants working on water environment issues in Southeast Asia and the surrounding regions . Interaction among participants will be expected through attractive platform and poster presentations. In addition, an interesting technical tour is scheduled on the first day of symposium to promote intercommunion among participants and understanding of local situations of water environment.

We do hope that strong network or partnership with active local agents will be established through the symposium, which then creates another opportunity for collaboration. Contribution of young professionals is one of the important factors of the symposium. Since the 7th SEAWE, the Award for Asian Young Professional on Water Research has been established with a support from the Ohgaki Scholarship fund. All applicants will receive an acknowledgment via e-mail upon the submission of the manuscript. According to peer review by program committee, platform and poster presenters will be selected. The corresponding author of platform presentation will be informed of the result of the review by early September.

Registration and Fee

The registration fee is 5,000 Thai Baht or 15,000 Japanese Yen, which will be collected at the symposium site. The fee includes full attendance for the three-day activities, including academic and social events, field trip and symposium proceedings as well as materials supplied by the symposium organizing office. Registration procedure will be informed later through the symposium webpage.
